## **USER INFORMATION**

This wood has been preserved by pressure-treatment with an EPA-registered pesticide containing inorganic arsenic to protect it from insect attack and decay. Wood treated with inorganic arsenic should be used only where such protection is important.

Inorganic arsenic penetrates deeply into and remains in the pressure-treated wood for a long time. However, some chemical may migrate from treated wood into surrounding soil over time and may also be dislodged from the wood surface upon contact with skin. Exposure to inorganic arsenic may present certain hazards. Therefore, the following precautions should be taken both when handling the treated wood and in determining where to use or dispose of the treated wood.

#### **USE SITE PRECAUTIONS**

- All sawdust and construction debris should be cleaned up and disposed of after construction.
- Do not use treated wood under circumstances where the preservative may become a component of food or animal feed. Examples of such sites would be use of mulch from recycled arsenic-treated wood, cutting boards, counter tops, animal bedding, and structures or containers for storing animal feed or human food.
- Treated wood should not be used where it may come into direct or indirect contact with drinking water, except for uses involving incidental contact such as docks and bridges.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Do not burn preserved wood.
- Wear NIOSH N95 dust mask and goggles when cutting or sanding wood.
- · Wear gloves when working with wood.
- Some preservative may migrate from the treated wood into soil/water or may dislodge from the treated wood surface upon contact with skin. Wash exposed skin areas thoroughly.
- All sawdust and construction debris should be cleaned up and disposed of after construction.
- Wash work clothes separately from other household clothing before reuse.
- Preserved wood should not be used where it may come into direct or indirect contact with drinking water, except for uses involving incidental contact such as fresh water docks and bridges.
- Do not use preserved wood under circumstances where the preservative may become a component of food, animal feed, or beehives.
- Do not use preserved wood as mulch.
- Only preserved wood that is visibly clean and free of surface residue should be used.
- If the wood is to be used in an interior application and becomes wet during construction, it should be allowed to dry before being covered or enclosed.
- Disposal Recommendations Preserved wood may be disposed of in landfills or burned in commercial or industrial incinerators or boilers in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.
- If you desire to apply a paint, stain, clear water repellent, or other finish to your preservative treated wood, we recommend following the manufacturer's instructions and label of the finishing product. Before you start, we recommend you apply the finishing product to a small exposed test area before completing the entire project to insure it provides the intended result before proceeding.

**CCA Treated Wood Pole 50 YEAR** LIMITED WARRANTY

This warranty extends ONLY to the original owner of the Chromated Copper Aresenate (CCA) treated pole, and is good for fifty (50) years from the date of first purchase. A 50 year limited warranty for CCA treated wood poles (treated to a minimum 0.60 pcf preservative retention level) in accordance with AWPA Standard T1-12 Section D.

Subject to the terms, conditions and limitations contained in this Warranty, Koppers Performance Chemicals Inc. (Koppers PC) warrants to the original owner (who is the final end user) of an Koppers PC CCA-treated wood pole that for a period of 50 years from the date of original purchase that such pole will not suffer damage caused by termites or fungal decay that makes the pole structurally unfit\* for the application for which it was intended (as defined by the National Electric Safety Code for the year of manufacture). In the event of a valid warranty claim, the owner of the original pole will be entitled, as the sole and exclusive remedy, to pro-rata reimbursement of the original price paid for the nonconforming Koppers PC wood pole.

• "Structurally unfit" shall be defined as the inability of a properly treated CCA wood pole to perform its intended function in a given application where the material has been used within an appropriate design not exceeding the material's reasonable limitations, due to fungal decay or termites.

#### HOW TO MAKE CLAIMS

To make a claim under the terms of this warranty, send a photograph and description of the damage along with the Koppers PC CCA Treated Wood Pole purchase receipt(s) from your CCA pole supplier. In addition, Koppers PC requires an itemized list of the damage to all CCA Treated Wood Poles, a photograph of the pole, identification of the pole owner and the address of the pole, a photo of the pole identification tag (if available), a burn brand or tag that incorporates the name or the Koppers PC wood pole producer including the name of the production plant, month/year of production, the pole species and preservative, and the circumference class and length. Koppers PC will, within sixty (60) days from the date of notice of your claim, and upon receipt of the proper documentation, make arrangements to reimburse on a pro-rata basis the cost of the original price paid for the non-conforming Koppers PC CCA treated wood pole. Koppers PC reserves the right to have a representative inspect all wood which is claimed to be damaged prior to its removal from service.

FOR CLARIFICATION PURPOSES, THE WARRANTY OFFERED HEREIN APPLIES TO KOPPERS PC CCA TREATED WOOD POLES, AND NOT TO ALL KOPPERS PC CCA PRODUCTS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION HEREOF TO THE CONTRARY, KOPPERS PC SHALL NOT BE LIABLE HEREUNDER FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: (A) DAMAGE TO ANY KOPPERS PC POLE RESULTING FROM ANY CAUSE OTHER THAN TERMITES OR FUNGAL DECAY; (B) DAMAGE TO ANY KOPPERS PC POLE THAT HAS BEEN USED IN A NON-UTILITY STRUCTURE OR A STRUCTURE OUTSIDE OF THE USA OR USED FOR AN APPLICATION OR IN A MANNER THAT IS NOT CONSISTENT WITH ITS INTENDED END USE (AS DEFINED BY THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC SAFETY CODE FOR THE YEAR OF MANUFACTURE); (C) DAMAGE TO ANY KOPPERS PC POLE THAT WAS NOT PRESSURE-TREATED SOLELY WITH KOPPERS PC CCA AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AMERICAN WOOD PROTECTION ASSOCIATION (AWPA) STANDARD U1 (AS MAY BE UPDATED FROM TIME TO TIME); OR (D) DAMAGE TO ANY Koppers PC POLE THAT DOES NOT BEAR (I) A BRAND OR TAG THAT INCORPORATES THE NAME OF THE KOPPERS PC WOOD POLE PRODUCER INCLUDING MONTH/YEAR OF PRODUCTION WITH QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM AND (II) THE MARK(S) OF A QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM OR AN INDEPENDENT INSPECTION AGENCY SHOWING ACCEPTANCE TO AWPA STANDARD U1.
